

POLICY # O.4
OBJECTIVES FOR THE SCHOOL YEAR

Goal # 1: Every school site and each student group will meet or exceed state and federal performance targets, or building level goals that are higher than state targets in reading and math as measured by API and AYP reports.

Goal # 2: Every school site and each student group will meet or exceed state and federal performance targets, or building level goals that are higher than state targets in reading and math as measured by API and

Goal # 3: Improvement of instruction in every classroom will be emphasized by each building administrator through monthly observations, timely evaluations, and appropriate assistance given where needed.

Goal # 4: The Eufaula Public Schools drop out rate will be lowered through collection and analysis of student data related to causes, including student characteristics, impact of grade or course requirements, social influences, and other factors, with recommendations for action by school personnel upon approval of Eufaula Board of Education.

Goal # 5: The school curriculum will be reviewed, updated and submitted for Board of Education review to ensure that all students at all grade levels are made aware of potential career options and receive instruction in life skills needed for productive citizenship.

Goal # 6: Beginning in kindergarten, all parents will be involved in the educational program of their children with increased emphasis on academic planning beginning at eighth grade level through parent meetings, personal conferences, and written documentation.
