# **Eufaula FFA Shooting Sports Policy**

## **Equipment and Practice**

Eufaula FFA is in possession of 5 shot guns, 4 clay target throwers, and 2 gun safes along with a continual supply of ammunition and clay targets. Practices for this event are held off of school campus at a safe designated area set up by the Agricultural Education instructors.

### **Participation**

To participate in this event students must be Eufaula FFA members and must have completed their 8 hour course of Hunter Education training and certification. Any Eufaula FFA member grades 9-12 can try out for this event as long as they can present a copy of their Hunter Safety training certification card. All equipment necessary for this event is provided by the Eufaula FFA. However on some occasions students may use their own shot guns depending on the contest the team is preparing for. In the event students are allowed to use personal shot guns they are never permitted to bring them on school campus.

### **Funding**

Funding for this program is provided solely through grant programs. The grants are written and submitted by the Eufaula FFA Agricultural Education Instructors. There are two separate grants programs that fund this activity. The Eufaula FFA receives \$4000-\$5000 per year from the Friends of the NRA grant program and Eufaula FFA received a one-time grant from the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife for joining their scholastic Shooting in the Schools program. For participation in The Scholastic Shooting in the Schools program allows Eufaula FFA to receive a \$2500 endowment each year. 5% of that endowment can be withdrawn from our account one time per year. The endowment can increase depending on our team placing but never decrease. The endowment program is sponsored by the Midway USA Foundation. All grans, endowments, and funds associated with the Eufaula FFA Shooting Sports program can only be spent on shooting sports equipment and activities.

#### **Storage**

Storage of the equipment is designated by the Agriculture Education Instructor with approval by the High School principal.
